

Privacy Policy

This privacy statement explains the information gathering and dissemination practices for this website and demonstrates our firm commitment to privacy. Information Collection and Use

The Psychological Society of America is the sole owner of the information collected on this site. Neither PSA nor its employees and contractors will sell, share, or rent this information to others in ways different from those specified in this statement. The Psychological Society of America collects information from its users at several different points on its website.

Log Files

Each time you visit our website we make a record of the following information:

- the IP address you connect from
- the list of pages you visit
- the time each page is visited
- the page from which you were referred to the current page
- the user agent (browser) used

The Psychological Society of America does not link this information to any individual user. We use this information to help diagnose problems with our server and to gather broad demographic information with which to improve the administration of our site. These files may be maintained indefinitely.

User Profiles

We also collect information from you when you register on our site, place an order, or subscribe to Issue Alerts. When ordering or registering on our site, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your name, email address, mailing address, or credit card information. You may, however, visit our site anonymously.

Cookies
